A Note on the Autumn 2003 Student Mobility Report

The Student Mobility Report is derived from data on incoming transfer students supplied by the registrar of each baccalaureate institution and by the office of the State Board for Community and Technical Colleges. Because data was not submitted for Northwest Indian College, City University, Henry Cogswell College, The Art Institute of Seattle or Antioch, the pages for these institutions reflect only transfers from these institutions.

To permit a clearer understanding of the data, the total undergraduate enrollment and the number of new freshmen entering directly from high school have been reported at the bottom of each page.

When reviewing or citing this report, please keep the following points in mind:

- The data reflect transfer student activity in Autumn 2003. This is not an annual summary. Experience suggests that the number of transfers for Winter and Spring terms are roughly half the number of Autumn transfers, or fewer. Still fewer transfer in the Summer.
- "Transfer students" means undergraduate students entering one college or university after having completed at least one term at another collegiate institution. The column "Other" reflects the entry of fifth-year or post baccalaureate students. Entrances to graduate programs are not included.
- Transfers from institutions outside the State of Washington are not included in the report.
