Introductions

SCC Building Self-Inspections-Scott Jones

Scott started by saying that the current building inspection list was updated. Summary of Incident/Accident Reports-Scott Jones

Very few Incident/Accidents were reported for the month of December. Scott reported the "loss time" injury summary report for last fiscal year equaled 1303 days missed. The normal average is 1.8 injuries per 1000 employees. District is 3.7 injuries per 1000 employees.

Executive Summary-Scott Jones

Security Update-Charles Hollen

Charlie reported that between December 1st and January 6th there were 76 total security issues reported. The reports included found property to malicious mischief, student misconduct and medical issues. Emergency phones are placed, tested and working. They will be tested monthly. 24 hour blue call stations are up and working on campus.

Overview of emergency procedures

Jim talked about adding the building evacuation procedure to the syllabus. He asked for input from the committee on editing the draft narrative for faculty at the beginning of each semester.

CCS Hazardous Waste Chemical Spill Response Plan.

Hazardous waste generator crates regulatory laws. 40 hours of hazardous waste classes are required with 8 hour annual refresher course.
